





A total of 1,632 patients were ministered to at one of the above clinic locations. Every patient was witnessed to, with 336 making a decision for the Lord.



William D. "Bill" Richardson, MD January 22, 1932 – July 21, 2014



illiam Donald "Bill" Richardson, M.D., 82, of Troy, IL. born Jan.22, 1932, in St. Louis, MO, died Monday, July 21, 2014, at his home.

Dr. Bill graduated from Dupo High School in 1950, Southern Illinois University, Carbondale, IL, in 1954 and from the University of Illinois Medical School, Chicago, IL, in 1958.

Dr. Bill was a member of Bethel Baptist Church, Troy, IL, since 1974. He served as Music Director, Deacon, Sunday School teacher, AWANA listener, church photographer and on many different committees.

Following residency at St. Louis City Hospital, St. Louis, MO, and one year of seminary at Midwestern Baptist Seminary in Kansas City, MO, he was appointed as a medical missionary in 1962 by the Southern Baptist International Mission Board to the Baptist Hospital in Nalerigu, Ghana, West Africa. Since then he made multiple medical mission trips to Venezuela, Cuba, Romania, Bulgaria and Paraguay. He was a past president of the Baptist Medical Dental Fellowship and, since 2009, a Board member of the Paraguay Baptist Medical Center Foundation.

He retired in 2012 as medical director of the St. Louis Behavioral Medicine Institute, Pain Management Program, Dept. of Community and Family Medicine, St. Louis University Health Sciences Center.

During the last Audio Conference Meeting of the Board on July 14, 2014, a week prior to his death, he opened the meeting with such heartfelt prayer for the work of our PBMCF and the ministry of Centro Médico Bautista in Asunción, Paraguay.

Surviving are his wife of nearly 61 years, Irma Jane Gowan Richardson, whom he married on Aug. 29, 1953, in the Lansdowne Baptist Church, East St. Louis, IL., his children: Daughters, Sharon (Charles) Walker, Marilyn (Herb) Jackson; his son, Donald (Annette) Richardson; his grandchildren: Philip Walker, Laura Walker, Melanie Richardson, William (Suzanne) Richardson, Benjamin Jackson and Amy Jackson (Christian) Perez; great-grandchildren: Ellie Perez, Maylie Perez and William Perez; and his brothers: Jim (Wanda) Richardson of Peoria, IL and Fred (Linda) Richardson of Jacksonville, FL.

Funeral Services were held Saturday, July 26, 2014, at the Bethel Baptist Church. Interment was at the Lake View Memorial Gardens, Fairview Heights, IL.

Bill will be fondly remembered for his great sense of humor, his commitment to his family, his friends, his church, his medical practice, Baptist Medical Dental Fellowship, and the Paraguay Baptist Medical Center Foundation. He was a Christian gentleman and reflected Christ in all areas of his life.
